# How to choose the right ID card printer for your business

## 1 Budget

ID card printers are a large investment. The cost of a printer can range from hundreds to thousands of dollars, depending on the type of printer, speed, and the supplies required.

While it may be tempting to choose the least expensive model, it's important to consider the longevity of printers. Many advanced models allow you to add features and upgrades as your business grows—saving you money in the long run.



## 2 Printer Type

There are two main options when choosing a printer—direct-to-card (DTC) or reverse transfer. These printer types use different technology to print images onto cards. The type of printer you choose will depend on your budget, expected volume, and customization needs.

### Direct-to-card

Direct-to-card printers—also known as DTC printers—are the most common type of ID card printer. These models use a dye-sublimation process. A printhead heats the panel of the ribbon and converts the ink into vapor. The printhead then diffuses images and text directly onto the surface of the ID card.

DTC printers are fast and affordable, with the ability to print large volumes of ID cards at a time. However, these printers will leave a white border around the edge of the card after printing.

### Retransfer printers

Retransfer printers—also known as reverse transfer printers—create durable and secure ID cards. These models use a two-step process, printing images on a clear film which is then diffused onto the card. This allows for edge-to-edge printing without any visible white space on the border.

Using a retransfer printer has many benefits. With an average resolution of 600 dpi, reverse transfer models provide unmatched image quality. These printers also offer enhanced customization and security features. And since the printhead doesn't come into contact with the ID card, retransfer printers can print on access control cards and uneven surface cards.

However, retransfer printers are more expensive. These models also need special film and ribbons, creating additional supplies and costs. Finally, with a more extensive printing process, retransfer printers can be slower than direct-to-card models.



### 3 Single-sided vs. dual-sided printers

Most direct-to-card and retransfer printers are available in single-sided or dual-sided models.

#### Single-sided printing

A single-sided printer only prints on one side of an ID card. Single-sided models are best for organizations with low-volume and simple printing needs. These models print basic cardholder information such as an employee's name and photo. Apart from being the most affordable, single-sided printers are easy to install and require little maintenance.

#### Dual-sided printers

With the ability to print on both sides of an ID card, dual-sided printers allow more options for customization. Organizations can print additional information such as employee information, important dates, and a list of emergency numbers. Dual-sided printers are best for medium and large-sized businesses with high-volume printing needs.

### 4 Speed

Determining the right speed will depend on your printing volume. Low-volume printers can print up to 100 cards per hour. High-volume printers—such as the Magicard 600—print over 300 cards per hour.

Faster models might need more supplies, such as high-capacity ribbons or large input and output hoppers.



## 5 USB, ethernet, and WIFI connectivity

All ID card printers come with a standard USB connection. However, if you want to operate your printer on a network, it's best to look for printers with Ethernet and WIFI connection options. A WIFI connection is the best option if you plan to travel with your printer.

## 6 ID Cards

Most printers use blank white cards to print photo IDs. ID cards come in three sizes:

**CR80:** The most popular ID card size. CR80 is the size of a credit card.

**CR79:** A slightly smaller size that is mostly used for access control.

**CR100:** This is the largest size available. While these cards are the most costly, they are ideal for printing large amounts of information.

## Ribbons



ID card printers require special ribbons that differ from your standard desktop printer ink or toner cartridges. These ribbons—known as YMCKO ribbons—are sectioned into a number of panels. “YMCK” refer to the colors (e.g., yellow dye, magenta dye, cyan dye, and black resin). “O” refers to the protective overlay.

For best results, you should purchase ribbons that are specific to your printer model.

## Laminations

Most high-end printers have built-in lamination capabilities. But while laminated cards are more durable, they are not always necessary. On average, standard ID cards without lamination last three to four years. The majority of cards will expire during this time or will be lost.

If you are looking for a more durable option, consider purchasing YMCKOO ribbons. These ribbons will provide 40% of the protection as lamination without the extra hardware—saving you money.

## Printer Warranties

Most ID card printers come with a warranty of two to three years. If your printer does break, some manufacturers offer loaner printers as part of your warranty.

For additional protection, consider purchasing Bodno's Extended Warranty. Our five-year warranty includes all labor and free replacement of parts. Our average repair time is less than three days, and all repairs include a free loaner.
