



How to share software Users database among multiple computers



When Bodno is installed for all users in the system, the database containing the software user and admin permissions, can be located under **C:\ProgramData\Bodno\USERS**.

The Bodno configuration file that will check the location of that database, can be found under **C:\ProgramData\Bodno**.

To share the same software Users database with multiple computers, the **users.mdb** file must be inserted in a folder that is being shared among all of them.

Then, we need to change the path that leads to the Users database, directly in the **Bodno.conf** file.


To do, it is necessary to replace the line **USERS=C:/ProgramData/Bodno/USERS** with the desired folder path.

Please remember to use / instead of the Windows default \.

After enabling the **User Logins** and **Auditing** features in the local Bodno applications or by copying an already configured Bodno configuration file to all computers, all logins and actions in the application will be displayed on any Auditing view, which is now loading all information from the relocated Users database.

In the image below, you can verify that the ADMIN has logged-in from 2 different computers.
